



Christy S. Coleman joined the American Civil War Museum in April 2008 and currently serves as the CEO. She began her career as a living history interpreter at the Colonial Williamsburg Foundation in 1984. In 1986 she became the Assistant Educator at the Baltimore City Life Museums in Baltimore, MD. In 1989 she returned to Colonial Williamsburg as a Senior Interpreter, but rose to become the Director of the African American Interpretations and Presentations (1994-1996). In 1996 Colonial Williamsburg named her Director of Midtown Operations, (1996-1998). In 1998, she was named Director of Programs, responsible for all daily and special public programming. From 1999 to 2005, Coleman served as President and CEO of the nation's largest African American museum, the Charles H. Wright Museum of African American History in Detroit, MI.
