

### **Outline of Instructions for Teachers To Give to Students About How Mission Tomorrow Will Run**

1. When you get off the bus at the Raceway, you will be part of a group of about 400 students that will progress through the exhibits together. In most cases, your entire school will fit within one group. Depending on the size of your school, there may be students from a different school in your group. All students in your group will wear a lei of the same color.
2. You will receive a list of sample questions that you may want to ask exhibitors to get information about their careers.
3. You will gather in the lobby of the first building for a short welcome talk.
4. Exhibitors will be separated into five zones. Each zone will have all the exhibitors relating to one or more of 16 career clusters. As you leave the welcome talk, you will receive a listing of exhibitors and a map showing the zones and exhibitor locations.
5. Generally, you will spend about 15 minutes in each zone, starting with Zone 1. At the end of the 15 minutes, an announcement will be made, and you must leave your current zone and move to the next zone. You cannot go back to a previous zone.
6. After the fifth zone, you will gather in a departure area and then walk out to your school's buses.
7. Volunteers wearing brightly colored *Mission Tomorrow* tee shirts will be stationed throughout the venue. Please ask them if you need assistance.
8. Water fountains and bathrooms are located at various locations throughout the venue.
9. An information desk and first aid station are located in the front lobby of the first building.
10. After the event, students can be eligible to win prizes such as ipads and Kings Dominion tickets if they complete the online post-event survey relating to careers of interest to you. The link for the survey is included on the map and listing of the exhibitors.
